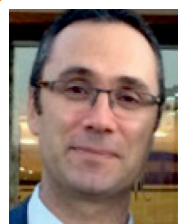
Manish Patel has been a Urological cancer Surgeon at Westmead Hospital, Sydney, Australia since 2003 and Associate Professor at the University of Sydney since 2010.

He gained his medical degree from the University of New South Wales in 1991 and his master's degree in 1996 from the University of Sydney. He held a fellowship in uro-oncology at the Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center, New York, NY in the USA from 2001 to 2003 and in 2008 he was awarded his PhD.

Dr. Patel is Director of the Urological Cancer Research Outcomes Centre at Westmead Hospital and a member of the Royal Australasian College of Surgeons board of surgical research with responsibility for research training, scholarships, policy and strategic direction in research.

He is the supervisor of training for urology at Westmead Hospital and block co-chair for urology/renal teaching at the University of Sydney. Additionally, he is currently an investigator in several clinical trials.

He is the author of numerous book chapters and books and has published over 70 papers in international peer-reviewed journals.

Juan Manuel Palacios is a Scientific Director for the Urology global medical team at GSK, currently based in Madrid, Spain.
